

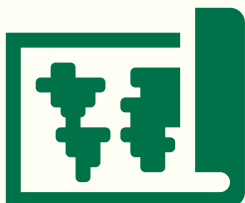

CONCERN IS BORN

With no humanitarian or fundraising experience — but a driving impulse to act in the face of great suffering — a group of young volunteers in Ireland launched an ambitious campaign to support relief efforts on the ground in Biafra. At the height of the crisis, an estimated 6,000 children were dying each week. Two of those volunteers, Aengus and Jack Finucane, would go on to build the organization that is now, almost 60 years later, Concern Worldwide.
